Samples must be delivered by and not later than 26th March 2021.

Samples shall be delivered by mail, courier or personally to the following address: Prolaz E. Jelušića 1, 52000 Pazin, Croatia. The parcel with samples shall contain:

1. 6 bottles of the same series, of 0.75 liter in volume or, for dessert wines only, of 0.5 or 0.375 liter in volume with labels. All bottles shall be packed into a single packaging unit. On the outside of the packaging the following shall be written in clear letters "SAMPLE – NOT FOR SALE" for "The World of Malvasia" International Competition;
2. A photocopy of the Registration Form;
3. Payment slip (photocopy) for €70,00 (seventy Euro) for each delivered wine, payable to: Vinistra – Association of Winegrowers and Winemakers; Istarska Kreditna Banka, Branch Office Poreč, Aldo Negri 2, 52440 Poreč, SWIFT CODE ISKBHR2X, IBAN HR3023800061110007193; purpose of payment: Entry Fee for "The World of Malvasia" International Competition. All bank charges shall be borne by the payer;
4. Pro-forma Invoice showing that samples are not for sale;
5. Report on analyses results, not older than six months, provided by a laboratory authorized in accordance with the laws of the country of origin and containing parameters listed in the Rules. The report shall bear the name of the producer submitting the wine and the name of the wine entered for competition together with all data necessary to identify the sample.

Results will be published on 5 May 2021.

All awarded participants will be informed by and not later than 21 April 2021, while the results will be publicly released on 5 May 2021 during the Awarding Ceremony which will take place within the annual wine exhibition "Vinistra 2021".

Note: Following the proposal of the OIV, under whose patronage the Competition will be held again this year, we would draw your attention to several technical details concerning evaluation: the final score shall be obtained on the basis of the average value by eliminating the highest and lowest scores; wine decantation shall be carried out in the room during the competition; and a greater attention shall be paid to the control of the production (only samples from a homogeneous batch of at least 1000 litres shall be eligible; on an exceptional basis samples from a reduced volume, of at least 100 litres, may be admitted upon written justification of a particular production).
